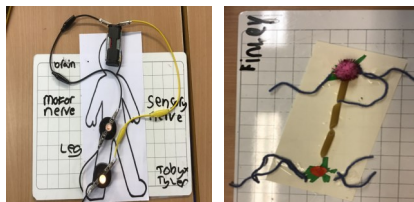
### Daily Mile
