What a super first two weeks we have had back at school. The children have all settled in well and are engaging in their learning in class. Behaviour is good with children trying their utmost to make the right choices in all aspects of their school lives.

The school environment has been improved further over the summer with Class 4 finally receiving long awaited minor building works and a coat of paint, together with repainting the lobby adjoining Class 3. We have also had new blinds installed in Classes 2, 3 and 4 which has really made a difference.

### Requests

**Parking Outside School**—we are only permitted to have **four cars** parked outside the front of school. I am also aware that many parents have received verbal abuse from passing motorists concerning their parking and the police are monitoring this situation.

**Parking at Timperleys**—Please can you use the car parks beside the hut or at the rear of the Community Hall whenever possible, rather than the road or the grass verge, as it is making it difficult for residents to access their homes.

**White Sheets**—if you have any clean, white sheets (flat rather than fitted) that you no longer require, we would be grateful of them in school to use for DT and art projects.

**Bag 2 Schools**—The HSA will be collecting good quality items for re-use for Bags 2 Schools. We are paid by weight of all the items collected. Acceptable items are: men's ladies' and children's clothing, paired shoes, handbags, belts and accessories. Unacceptable items are: uniforms, workwear, pillows, duvets or pieces of fabric.
