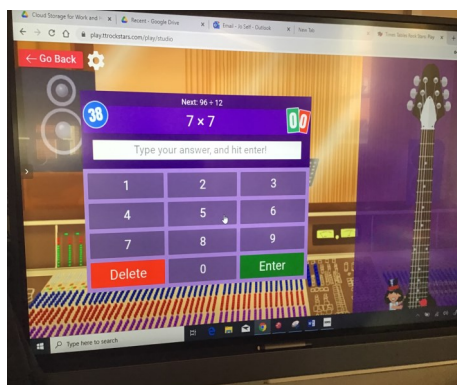

This week we have had installed a touchscreen into each of the remaining two classes—this will kindly be partly funded by the HAS.

We have also bought membership of Times Tables Rock Stars this year from our Covid Catch Up funding which has already shown amazing results in KS2 with battles in classes resulting in rapidly improving scores for both accuracy and speed. This is also available to access at home. Our zone area is finally near completion after being part of our EYFS reorganisation and is now providing an enhanced learning space for children to use out of the classroom, as well as an area for us to proudly display our school achievements.



### Updates/Requests
