### Christmas Plans

We are determined to try to give the children as ‘normal’ a Christmas as possible in school despite all of the Covid restrictions, although reluctantly we have had to accept that things will have to be adapted to some extent.

We are planning on the following:

**Christmas Cards**—the children have designed their own Christmas Cards and some other small gifts which we hoped you might like especially as it is currently more difficult to visit older relations. The last date for orders is Tuesday 10th November. Cheques should be made payable to the HSA.

**Christmas Nativity**— We are planning on recording a nativity with EYFS and KS1 as usual but with a performance that keeps the two bubbles separate. This will be shown on Tuesday 15th December via zoom.

**Christmas Lunch**—We will still hold a Christmas Lunch in school for the Children . This will be eaten in their class bubbles on Wednesday 16th December.

**HSA Christmas Jumper Day**— On Wednesday 16th December children will be able to wear a Christmas Jumper to school (with the rest of their uniform as usual please). There will be a voluntary donation of £1 for this to go towards the HSA funds.

**Virtual Pantomime Visit**— We are currently booking an online pantomime for this year.

**Christmas Collective Worship**—We will be holding a Christmas Collective Worship over zoom where we will have the traditional readings by Class 4 on Friday 18th December.
