Reminders

The current arrangements for children arriving at school in the morning are that the gate opens at 8:40am and both children and adults are welcomed onto the playground. Children are the parents responsibility (they can be passed to our on duty parents, especially if you have parked outside and need to drop and run) until 8:50 when the bell is rung for the beginning of the school day. Once all of the children and parents have left the playground the front gate is shut. If your child arrives at school after this time you will need to **accompany them to the office to sign them in**. If your child arrives between 9:05 and 9:20 then they will receive a late mark. After this it is classed as an unauthorised absence unless agreed with the school. On wet weather mornings children will go straight into school. Due to safeguarding regulations, parents are not permitted into school in the mornings. If you have a message for the class teacher the office will be happy to pass this on for you. Thank you all for your support with this.
