The Christian Bible talks of God seeing humans as his jewels in the making (Malachi 3:16-17).

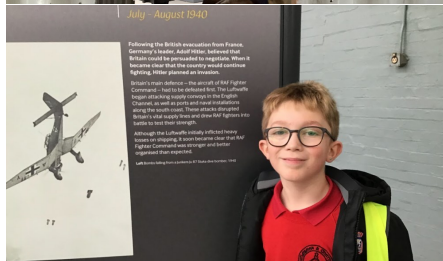
