A great opportunity to get in the Christmas spirit with other parents, enjoy festive traditions (Santa's grotto, mulled wine, mince pies and more) and, most importantly, raise funds for the school.

We do need your help to make this a success...

- Donations tombola, sweets/chocolate tombola and raffle
 - Boxes will be in the playground morning and afternoon from Monday 19th November for any donations towards the tombola and raffle. The boxes will be available every day until Thursday 13th December

- Donate sweets and/or chocolates and your child/children can wear non-school uniform on Friday 7th December
- Santa's grotto book your ticket in advance
 - Look out for a form in book bags to book your child/children's visit to see Santa.
 - All booked visits will happen during school hours. If you don't book in advance, a queuing system at the fayre applies
- Raffle tickets purchase and sell as many as you can
 - A book of raffle tickets (50p per ticket) will be in school bags over the next few weeks for you to purchase and/or sell to friends and family
 - Raffle ticket sales (completed stubs and money) are to be handed into the school office by Wednesday 12th December
 - o If you do not wish to purchase/sell your raffle tickets, please hand back to the office asap
- The Giving Machine sign up in time for Christmas shopping
 Join (for free!) the Giving Machine to raise funds for our school every time you shop online
