



Coding in KS2

In Class 3, the children were asked to design their own dancing robot, add a background, and create a button that when tapped makes the robot dance. They used Event, Movement, Sound, and Repeat blocks to create the dance and had to have at least 10 dance moves. The button communicated with the robot through a send and receive signal. They worked independently to de-bug their programming if it didn't work and had the challenge of adding music.



In Class 4, using Co-Space, children were asked to design and create scenes to retell a traditional tale of their choice. They then animated and wrote code for the characters to help tell the story. Children were challenged to record themselves telling the story and add the audio over the top.



English in KS1

In English, the children were exploring things found at the seaside through their senses. They looked at different items closely through magnifying glasses, listened to seaside sounds and guessed what they were and had some feely bags of seaside items. The seaweed was a bit of a surprise!
