Curriculum

This term, our English work will include writing playscripts and explanation texts based on the human skeleton in addition to traditional poems. Later in the term, we will be writing a rainforest inspired narrative, non-chronological reports and poems that create images. In addition, we will work hard to improve joined handwriting, reading and comprehension skills and spelling and grammar. Maths work will cover fractions, time, statistics and shape. We will also be working hard to secure our times tables knowledge.

Our topic work this term includes learning about Spain and the Mayan civilisation. We will be sewing, and preparing dishes based on herbs and British produce in Design and Technology. Our P.S.H.E. learning this term centres around how we grow and what keeps us safe, as well as what families are like. In Science, we will explore diet and nutrition and the musculoskeletal system. Later in the term we will learn about plants. Our R.E. topics will explore key concepts in Christianity and the Kingdom of God as well as stories and symbols from Judaism. In Music, the whole class will be enjoying improvisation and composing using their imagination. In Computing, children will begin by learning about nature art and then dinosaurs.

P.E. will take place on a Monday Wednesday. This term P.E. includes athletics, cricket, rounders and tennis. Please make sure your child has suitable named clothing and footwear for indoor and outdoor P.E. lessons.
