



# LEAVE OF ABSENCE REQUEST FORM

It is essential for pupils to attend school every day to get the most out of their school experience, including their attainment, wellbeing and wider life chances. As parents/carers, you have a legal responsibility to ensure your child's attendance at school.

This form should be completed if you know in advance of a reason as to why your child will not be attending school, including for any medical appointments.

Headteachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. In-line with the national framework for penalty notices issued by the DfE, unauthorised absences of 5 days (10 sessions) or more within a 10-week rolling period may result in the issue of a penalty notice.
